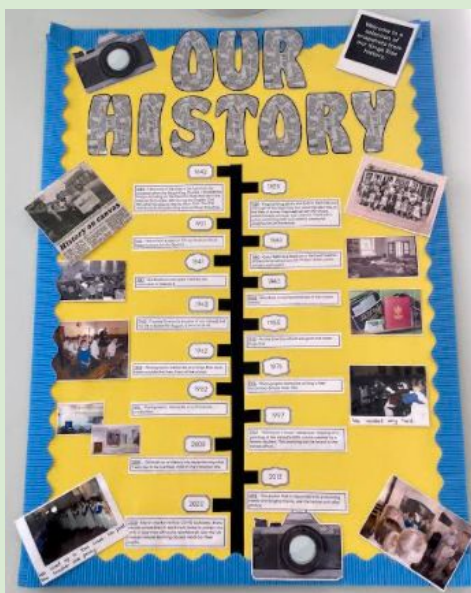




## IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM WEST MIDLANDS POLICE

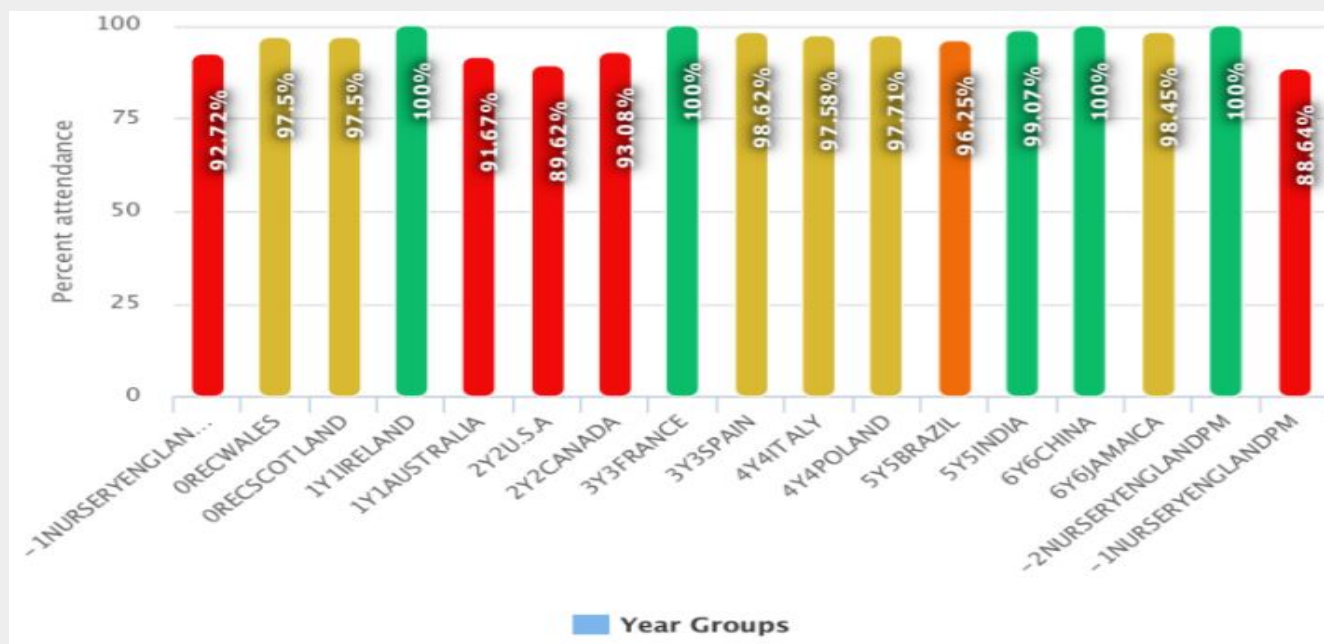

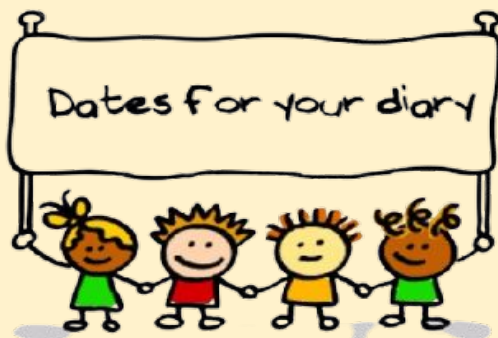
