Dear Parents

We have had another lovely week in Foundation learning about bugs and minibeasts. Our caterpillars have all spun their cocoons and everyone is enjoying watching them, drawing and writing about them, and making predictions. In literacy we have been writing about the butterfly's life cycle and in maths we have been practicing naming and describing 3d shapes, as well as addition and subtraction by counting on and back, and by using a number line.

School Jumpers

We have a couple of jumpers in the classroom that don't have a name in, so if you have lost a jumper you are welcome to come and speak to a member of the Foundation team and we will bring them to you to see if one is yours. Please can everyone have a look in their child's jumper and hoodie to check that their child's name is in and that you have the correct jumper at home. Thank you.

Things To Practise At Home

- Can your child make a number line to 20? Can you write a couple of addition and subtraction problems and can your child solve those problems by using the number line? Can they remember which way to jump on or back for addition and then for subtraction problems?
- Write a list of food that the Hungry Caterpillar eats. Remind your child that each word goes underneath the last one in a list.
- Read your child's reading book with them and pop a comment onto Tapestry to let us know how they got on at home.
