Although unlikely, due to the high case numbers in our local area, if government restrictions change, ahead of the event, our plans will be reviewed. Year 6 Leavers Events

As you will be aware, this week, the decision was made to delay the progression onto the next stage of the government 'Road Map'. This means that restrictions on gatherings, particularly indoors, remain in place. Following an update of our risk assessment, we have made the decision that it will not be possible to invite families into the school hall to watch our Year 6 leavers' performance. Instead, this year, the performance will be recorded and distributed to the parents. If government restrictions change prior to the end of term, we review arrangements and update parents. On 21st July, the Y6 children will be taking part in an end of year trip. The children will be transferred by coach, to the Trafford Centre, where we have booked Paradise Island Crazy Golf and dinner as well as bowling at Namco Funscape. To assist with the cost of the visit, we are asking for a contribution of £17.50 per child which is payable via ParentPay.
