FATHER DAVID

As some of you may already know, Father David has been asked by the Archbishop to move to a different parish. Obviously a parish priest will always be obedient to the wishes of the Archbishop, so it is with great sadness that we can confirm that Father's last weekend in the parishes of St. Anne's and Corpus Christi will be the 3rd and 4th July. It would have been great if he could have stayed for the end of the academic year to say goodbye and to lead the mass for our year 6 leavers, but sadly that is not going to be possible. Our new priest's first weekend will be the week after, on the 10th and 11th July. Then, we will be able to welcome Father Stephen Fawcett to our parishes. We will of course welcome him into school to meet all of the children and staff as soon as he is settled.

SPORTS DAY

This year's sports day (weather permitting) will be on Tuesday 20th July.

Unfortunately, this year, regardless of whether further lifting of restrictions have been allowed, we are not permitted to invite parents onto school site as spectators. We will still do our very best to make sure it is a lovely occasion for the children. You will probably recognise that this is the last day that the children are in school before they break up for the summer holiday. We have done this intentionally, so that they have a lovely last day with their friends. Please can the children come in their school PE kits.

TRANSITION

With the ongoing COVID restrictions, transition will have to look very different this year. We are still finalising the details, but plans that had been put in place to support the transition of our secondary children have been stopped. We are hoping to hear more information from the secondary schools soon—we will share any information we have as soon as we have it. I am still finalising the details with staffing for next year. Once all of this is also finalised, we will be in a position to share the teacher your child will have next year. I am so sorry that it is so late, but it is beyond my control to be able to tell you any sooner. We hope to be able to invite all of our new Nursery starters into the setting once we start back in September.

You will see that next year's term dates are included as part of this newsletter. You will see that the children's first day back in school after the summer holiday is Monday 6th September. Let's hope that the next academic year is an uninterrupted one and we remain in school for the duration.

SAFETY AT THE END OF THE DAY

Thank you to the vast majority of our parents who adhere to the instructions given regarding safe leaving at the end of the school day. I know we do give the same message repeatedly, but the safety and education of our young children is too important for us not to give reminders. Please can you stick to the path on leaving the school site. I see some children, encouraged by their parents, to cut through the car park. If this is witnessed by a member of staff, we will send a personal email to the parents/carers of the children to give a direct reminder. We constantly tell the children it is not safe to cut through, as cars can leave or enter the car park at any time. Scarily, we sometimes see our youngest children run across the entrance to the school without holding an adult's hand. That is essentially a road that they are not being supervised near. We cannot see round the corner at the front of the school and a car could. And has previously, enter the site at any time. Please, please hold your child's hand—especially if they are very young—so we do not have a tragedy on our hands.

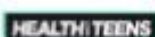
