The children have had a great Enterprise Week! They have been making slime, ready to sell next week. The children created lovely posters of what the slime is going to look like, whether it was glittery, rainbow or with charms.

In maths this week the children have been looking at dominoes, they've been counting and estimating the dots, adding them together and talking about what would happen if we took one away and added one more. The children were using great mathematical language.

The children have been loving sitting in the book area and reading stories to each other. They have started to talk to each other about the pictures that they see in the books and talk about what they liked and disliked about the stories.

The children have been stretching whilst painting. The teachers taught the children that they can use lots of different things to paint with, from paintbrushes to fingers to toothbrushes. The children have painted on large scales and used their bodies to stretch across the paper.
