Pond and woodland improvements

Thank you to Dave Spence and Adam Faulconbridge who joined Mr Finlay, Mrs Pector, Mr Green and myself clearing the pond and woods area on 19th June. It was great to make this area more accessible for the children. We will be doing further work in September to finish the pond clearance and hope that more parents will be able to join us. Sports Day – 7th July

As per my previous communication, we are looking forward to welcoming you on the 7th July for Sports Day. We will be holding the Sports Day as follows:

Early Years 9am - 10am

Key Stage 1 10.30am - 12 noon

Key Stage 2 1pm - 3.15pm

We hope parents understand that the Sports Day will not be able to run as usual and the guidelines mean that the following must be in place:

- Parents and children will be in class bubbles and will not mix with other classes
- Children will wear the normal PE kit and do not need house team coloured t-shirts
- Social Distancing must be adhered to
- Only 1 parent per child may attend, so that numbers do not exceed 30 in a class bubble
- All events will take place outside
- Parents will not have access to toilet facilities on the premises
- Families with more than 1 child in a key stage may send more than 1 adult as long as there is 1 adult per child per class
- Parents will not be able to stay on the premises, including the field, between key stages.
- We will not be able to hold a family picnic, as per previous years.

Thank you for your understanding with these rules.

Reports and Transition Dates

Reports will be coming home to you on Tuesday 12th July.

Unfortunately, due to government guidance on indoor mixing still being in place, we will not be able to hold the planned 'Meet the teacher' session for parents on Wednesday 14th July. However, our Transition Day on Thursday 15th July, where children move up to their new class for the day, will still go ahead. On this day please bring your child to school as follows:

Year 5 (current Year 4) – Year 5-6 Door at 8.30am – 3.05pm
Year 6 (current Year 5) – Year 5-6 Door at 8.40am – 3.15pm


Classes next year
