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## Polite Reminders ...

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### Alert Email for Covid 19 Symptoms

If any person in your family unit falls ill with COVID 19 symptoms, receives a positive test result or your child is required to self-isolate, please alert school as soon as possible via our designated email address – [sjhgnotifications@questrust.org.uk](mailto:sjhgnotifications@questrust.org.uk)

This will then enable us to take the appropriate action and fulfil our contact-tracing obligations. Please continue to use Class Dojo for all other communication with your child's class teacher.



Please can we remind you that lateral flow tests are not to be used if your child or someone in your household displays Covid-19 symptoms. This is made very clear on the Government website and we need to follow this guidance strictly. If your child or someone in your household is displaying symptoms, please arrange a PCR test and self-isolate until these results come back. Please see further guidance below:

Or if you prefer, you can drop in to one of the many walk-in clinics: Walk-in Vaccine Clinics - Healthier Wigan Partnership. The walk-in clinics are offering first doses of the Pfizer vaccine to anyone aged 18 and above. If you need a second dose, you can call 01942 807780 to book an appointment. You won't be able to book until you are at or near 8 weeks if you are aged 40+, or at or near 12 weeks if you are under 40.
