Read on for ways to support and encourage your child with reading over the summer holidays!

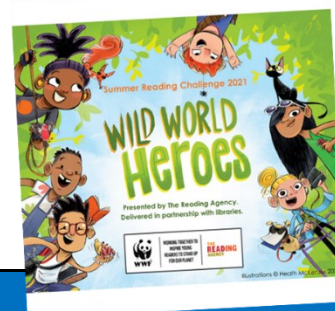
#### Leamington Library Opening Hours

This year's Summer Reading Challenge runs from Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> July – Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> August.  
You can sign up and take part at your local library.  
Children are being asked to read 6 books over the course of the holiday (non-fiction, fiction or poetry, picture books or books read with parents/carers). As the children read the books, they will be able to collect stickers. When they have read all 6 they will be awarded a medal and certificate. The challenge is also run online if you cannot get to a library, and the children will receive digital rewards in place of stickers/medal!

#### EBooks

You can join your local library online. Once joined, you can download and access an App called BorrowBox.

Read up to eight eBooks and eight eAudio books on Apple and Android tablets and phones.

Download for up to three weeks. No more overdue fees as your items are automatically returned when your loan period ends!



### Oxford Owl—Reading Scheme Books

The Oxford Owl eBook Library contains a wide selection of books from across Oxford's most popular series. The books are carefully levelled and progress in reading difficulty from those appropriate for Reception right through to those suitable for Year 6. These are accessible to download for free online. If you are unsure of your child's reading level, please ask your child's teacher.

Click on the 'Log in' link (top right) to open the login form.

Make sure the 'Students' tab is highlighted. Type in the class name and password that your child, and click 'Login'.
