It is lovely to see the children enjoying nature. We are making the most of our outdoor environment and also bringing nature into our classrooms to enhance our learning.

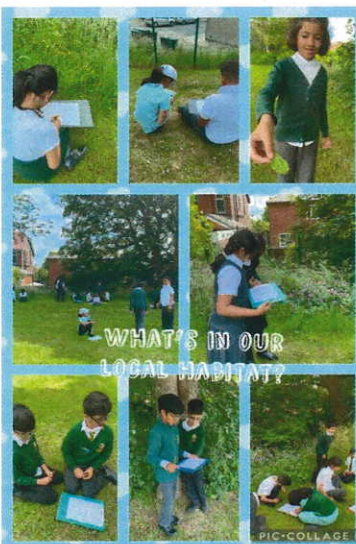

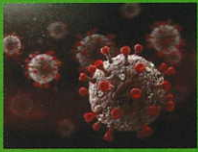
News and Notices

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Covid Update!!

You will have received a letter from school regarding additional symptoms of Covid-19. These include: fever, new and continuous cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, loss of appetite, loss of smell, loss of taste, myalgia, sore throat, headache, nasal congestion, diarrhoea, nausea, and vomiting. If your child has any of these symptoms they must go for a **PCR test**. (This is not an LFT test!!) **This is supported by Public Health England and Rochdale Local Authority**
