### Covid Vaccine information

COVID19 is circulating again in our Borough, with the number of cases currently increasing. Wigan Public Health would encourage you to get vaccinated as soon as you can.

From Wigan Public Health: Need a COVID vaccine? Ring 01942 807780 to book

If you haven't yet had a COVID19 vaccine, you can book an appointment in any of our local clinics by calling 01942 807780. Or if you prefer, you can drop in to one of the many walk-in clinics: [Walk-in Vaccine Clinics - Healthier Wigan Partnership](#).

The walk-in clinics are offering first doses of the Pfizer vaccine to anyone aged 18 and above.

If you need a second dose, you can call 01942 807780 to book an appointment.

You won't be able to book until you are at or near 8 weeks if you are aged 40+, or at or near 12 weeks if you are under 40.

**Please remember to take out your child's earrings on their PE day.**



As the weather is getting warmer, please remember to apply sun cream to your child before school and make sure they bring a sunhat into school if needed.

Children are allowed to bring 2 water bottles into school as we are currently unable to refill water bottles.

### Important Covid-19 information

If any person in your family unit falls ill with Covid-19 symptoms, receives a positive test, or your child is required to self-isolate, please alert school as soon as possible via our designated email address:

This will then enable us to take the appropriate action and fulfil our contact-tracing obligations. Please continue to use Class Dojo for all other communication with your child's class teacher.

Please can we remind you that lateral flow tests are not to be used if your child or someone in your household displays Covid-19 symptoms. This is made very clear on the Government website and we need to follow this guidance strictly.

If your child or someone in your household is displaying symptoms, please arrange a PCR test and self isolate until these results come back.
