[Continuing COVID-19 measures in schools until the end of term](#)

As you'll be aware, Step 4 of the national unlocking roadmap will come into effect from Monday 19th July. In Coventry and Warwickshire, because of rising numbers of positive cases, (currently at 354 per hundred thousand compared to 50 a month ago) we will be keeping all our site measures in place until the end of term. We feel this is particularly important considering recent school bubble closures to minimise further spread of COVID-19 whilst isolation guidance is still in place.

See these outlined below:

1. A **staggered start** to the beginning and end of each school day (same times and organisation).
2. Asking parent/ carers to **wear facemasks** when on school site dropping off and picking their children up.
3. Encouraging **social distancing between different families** whilst on the school site.
4. Staff wearing masks in and around the school site but not routinely in classrooms.
5. Ensuring **well-ventilated rooms** with having windows and doors opened routinely across the school site.
6. **Minimising face-to-face contact** with our office teams where possible.
7. Continuing with our **enhanced hygiene procedures** in school.
8. Asking children to **regularly wash/ sanitise their hands** when appropriate.

We will be looking through all new DfE school guidance over the summer and informing you of how we will be operating in our schools from September towards the end of the holiday.

Thank you for all your support over this academic year. At times, it has not always been easy, but the staff have really appreciated you sticking to our guidance to show your support for what we have been doing.
