Dear Parents and Carers,

I cannot believe I am already writing the penultimate newsletter of the academic year. It has certainly been a strange year, I am just hoping that we manage to make it through to Wednesday without any closures. Several schools around us have had bubbles out, the cases seem to be increasing every day! I just hope we make to the end with our school intact and together for the end of the year.

This newsletter is simply to inform you of the procedures for the last week of term. The final newsletter for the year will be sent out on Wednesday, when we will say our final goodbye to our amazing year 6 children.

Monday will be our May Day. The children will all get ready in their classrooms, should you like us to do hair etc. please pop in a hair-brush and bands etc. Once the children have finished their dancing and the pageant we will take them all back into their classrooms to get them changed before they join you to look around the stalls. We will be opening the back gates at 9.15 Monday morning for those parents who are helping to set up for the event. For any parents running stalls, we suggest that you arrive after lunchtime to set up, you may drive your cars on the field as usual. We are looking for any dads with power tools who may have an hour spare on Monday morning straight after drop off to help put the castle together—it is quite a heavy job, the whole framework needs screwing together—any offers of help will be gratefully received! Please just come to the playground when you drop your child off and we will direct you to where you will need to go! Any food donations for the refreshment stall can come into the office on Monday morning. We will be leaving the school at approx. 3.15 to gather at the church ready for our procession back to the school. The children will enter school via the main gate and parents will walk around to the back field gate to enter the school field.

Could I please remind you about parking for this event. The roads become very congested at the end of the school and we will have extra people arriving to watch the event. We have already had complaints from neighbours about the parking. Please use the park and ride as an alternative. Should the overflow car park at The Bell be ready for parking I will notify you via an alert on Monday morning.

Tuesday is disco day! The children may bring in a change of outfit for the disco—once again please send them in with any hair equipment and we will do our best to help with any hair styles needed! The disco will end at 5.00p.m. you will need to collect your child via the back field gate. You will be able to download any photos from the disco using the code given on their ticket which is going home tonight.

Tuesday will also be our last Celebration Worship which did not take place last Friday . Sorry there will be no zoom link.

Wednesday will be our last day. Our Leaver's Service will now take place on the school field rather than the church due to the restrictions in numbers allowed into the church and the limited space. All are now welcome to join us for the Leaver's Service. Please bring chairs or rugs to sit on. Please arrive between 10.45 and 11.00a.m., we aim to start shortly after 11.00a.m. Any families watching the service are welcome to join their child for a picnic after the service. Year 6 and siblings will leave school after the picnic. Anyone wishing to collect their child before the end of the school day may do so via the front gate between 1.00 and 1.30.

Our first day back will be Thursday 2nd September.
