Trumpet lessons



Wider Opportunities

Our Year 3 children in Offer Class will be learning the trumpet this year as part of their Music curriculum. Our school takes part in the Wider Opportunities scheme each year to offer all children in Key Stage 2 the chance to learn to play an instrument. Children in Year 3 will spend the first few weeks working on rhythm patterns before being given an instrument. The year's tuition in Year 3 is fully funded by school and free to all families. The children then get chance to take part in the 'Further Opportunities' scheme and continue to learn and develop their instrument the following year and beyond.

Further Opportunities

After a year of learning an instrument in Year 3, children can continue to learn their instrument in small groups the following year as part of the Further Opportunities scheme. The lessons equate to approximately £1.50 per lesson and the child continues to get free loan of the instrument they are learning. We have a few children that are receiving the trumpet lessons this year – **if your child would like receive lessons please ask the office for a form.** The lessons are open to all children in Year 4, 5, & 6 (Key Stage 2) If your child is in receipt of Pupil Premium funding, please speak to the office as the lessons can be offered as part of their entitlement. We would love to be able to offer concerts to parents in the near future and as a musician myself I would love to think we could have a mini-orchestra at Stanton☺

Flu Immunisations



Dear Parents/Carers

For the school year starting September 2021, we will be continuing with the e-consent for the Flu Programme. This year we will be offering the Nasal Flu vaccination to children in **Reception, Year 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6.** **When completing the e-consent please state the year group your child will be in at the beginning of the school year September 2021 NOT their current year group.**

Please visit <https://www.derbyshireandcityimms.co.uk/Forms/Flu> to complete the consent form. The option to consent or decline the vaccination is at the end of the questionnaire so please complete even if you do not want your child to have the vaccination.

If you wish to decline the Flu spray due to the porcine element we are now able to offer an alternative injectable Flu vaccine that does not contain porcine. Please complete the consent form as a decline due to vaccine ingredients and we will then contact you to arrange vaccination. For more information, please contact the team as below.
