Celebration Assembly

It was the turn of children from Reception, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6 to share their favourite learning during this week's Celebration Assembly. I visited Year 1, Year 3 and Year 5 later in the day to find out what they have enjoyed!

Reception children have enjoyed making tearing paper pictures. They have been using different materials to form fantastic collages. They got a big clap from the other children in assembly when they revealed one of their design!

Year 1 have enjoyed learning about the creation story and have shown great creativity by displaying the 7 days of creation using play-doh! They have also been working very hard to improve their phonics understanding.

Year 2 read out some wonderful letters that they had written to Mrs Heckman about why they could not come to school! Their handwriting, and inventive reasons why they couldn't attend school, were very impressive!

Year 3 have enjoyed counting in different steps to 100 and 1,000. They are very passionate about their class novel, 'Stone Age Boy' and have used this as inspiration to write their own expanded noun phrases.

Year 4 have enjoyed creating comic strips of the story of Romulus and Remus. Their PE work in Gymnastics (and swimming of course!) were also among their highlights of the week.

Year 5 have shown great enthusiasm with their story writing this week. They have also been fascinated in comparing the Genesis and scientific accounts of the creation story.

Year 6 are showing fantastic knowledge and enthusiasm for their learning about WW2. This morning they shared information about evacuation. In maths, they have also enjoyed challenging themselves to round numbers up to 1 million!
