To Parents / Carers of pupils in year 2 at an Infant School

Dear Parent / Carer,

Applying for a Year 3 place in Junior School for September 2022

Your child is due to move on to Junior School in September 2022 having completed the infant phase of their education and you now need to apply for a Junior School place for your child.

How to apply

The easiest and quickest way to apply is online at www.westnorthants.gov.uk/admissions.

The application process opens on 10th September 2021 and you will need to register using an email address. Alternatively, you may wish to complete a paper application form which you can request from the School Admissions Team (contact details above).

You may also download a copy of the composite prospectus from our website; 'Applying for a Primary School Place in West Northamptonshire 2022/23', and you are advised to read this carefully before making your application.

In addition to your application form, some schools will also require you to complete a supplementary information form (SIF). The list of the schools for which you need to complete a SIF can be found on our website. SIFs must be returned directly to the school. For schools requiring a SIF, your application will not be complete unless you complete and return both the application form and the SIF by the closing date.

Closing date for applications

Your application form must reach us by 5 p.m. on 15th January 2022. Failure to do this may affect your chances of obtaining a place for your child at your preferred schools.

Pupils with an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHC Plan)

If your child has an EHC Plan, you do not need to apply for a school place using the process explained above. Instead, you will receive a letter from the EHC Team seeking details of your school preference.

Pupils living outside West Northamptonshire

If your home address is outside West Northamptonshire (even if your child attends a West Northamptonshire infant school), you should apply to the local authority where you live (your home local authority), not WNC. Contact details of neighbouring local authorities can be found on our website.

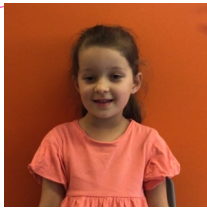
