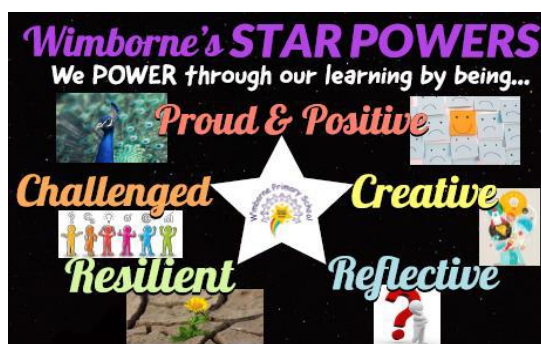


Our school motto - 'Reach for the stars'
