Dear Parents / Guardians,

Swimming

Year 6 will be taking part in swimming lessons after half term until the Christmas holidays. The children will be going swimming every **Thursday morning** at Oak Park Leisure Centre and will need to ensure that they bring their swimming kit to school with them each week on this day. They will need:

- Swimming costume or swimming shorts
- Swimming hat
- Towel
- Goggles (if required) – school cannot provide goggles due to hygiene reasons

Any children with earrings must remove them for swimming. If children are not able to do this independently, they should be removed at home before they come to school.

If your child requires swimming aids, such as arm bands, they may bring their own. Alternatively, there are a variety of swimming aids available to use at the leisure centre if you would rather your child use these.

The children will be transported by coach to and from Oak Park.

The first session will take place on **Thursday 4th November.**
