### Firework lunch

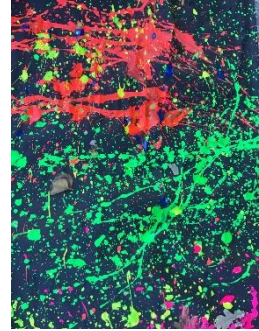
Our firework themed lunch and non- uniform day was a huge success on Friday. Thank you for your donations which were added to the FOSP pot for Saturday night.

The children in Mulberry class made diva lamps and colourful fireworks and firework pictures.



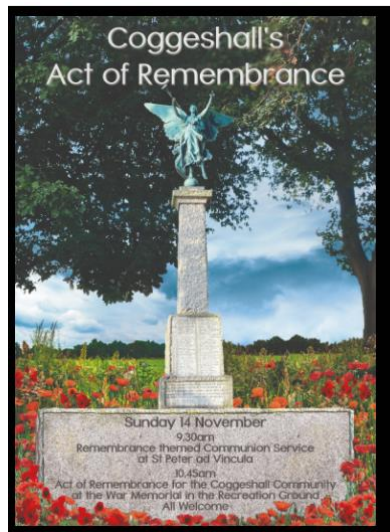
The children in Sycamore class made these amazing space pictures.

## Reception admissions for academic year starting in September 2022

The primary school (Reception) admission round opens on **Monday 8 November 2021**, for parents of children to apply for a Reception school place for the academic year that starts in September 2022.

The statutory national closing date for applications is **15 January 2022**.
