Yesterday we went to the memorial in the churchyard where we observed two minutes silence. The children were as always exceptional and very respectful. Huge thanks to Nye for joining us to play the Last Post on his cornet, and to Year 6 for reading the names of the East Haddon fallen. This morning I have received an email from a man who was passing as we gathered. He would normally have joined his own village but work took him away so he pulled over and joined us. He lost his grandfather in WW1 and wanted to let me know how much it meant to him to see our children paying their respects.

Our rescheduled parents' evening is this Wednesday 17th and appointments (phone and in person) have now been sent out. Thank you to everyone who responded. If you missed the previous communications and would like an appointment please contact the office. Please note that as we still have cases of Covid, and in order to keep everyone safe, it is only one parent per meeting and masks must be worn in school.
