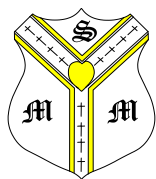

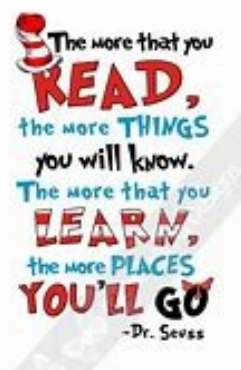
They have also learned about 'unkindness' and this can make someone feel as well.

5. Praise the effort. Praise your child for 'having a good try'.
6. If your worried about your child's progress in reading, speak to their class teacher.
