I am delighted to say the school have been awarded the Basic Skills Quality Mark, for the 5<sup>th</sup> time, after our recent re-assessment. This demonstrates the school continues to develop all children with their basic English & Maths skills, very effectively. Thank you to everyone who contributed to the school gaining this award.

We feel that the school can have limited audiences for our Nativity and Advent Services. At the Key Stage 2 Advent services, dates of which can be found below, we can allow one parent/carer per child to attend. We ask that masks are worn, and all services will be in the hall. Unfortunately we won't be able to serve refreshments once the service has finished. We are changing the Nativity production arrangements.
