These are our arrangements.

Morning arrangements

8:40-8:50 children to walk down the path to class. An adult will meet your child at the top of the path.

8:40- 8:50 the children transported by bus will arrive at school through the main gate (access for these children only via the car park gate).

End of day arrangements

3:10 – Afternoon Nursery

3:15 – Foundation Phase (Reception, yr1, yr2)

3:20 – Key Stage 2 (Yr 3, 4, 5, 6) and buses

Where to collect your child at the end of the day

Nursery/Reception – Nursery entrance

Year 1-6 – via the rear yard to your child's class door

Pupils will not move to sibling classes at the end of the day

We kindly ask that you

- Wear a mask on the school grounds
- Use the pedestrian route to access the school
- Remember that only the children travelling on the bus will use the car park gate
- Keep to the left on the pedestrian path

- Keep your distance where possible
- Adhere to the speed limit of 5 miles per hour when driving down the road
