Harefield Infants and Nursery School believes that our pupils have the right to learn in a clean and healthy litter free environment.

Responsibilities

Staff:

- Remind everyone not to drop litter through the taught curriculum and assemblies
- Support pupils and help them deal with litter problems

Pupils:

- Don't drop litter
- Use litter bins provided
- Be responsible for keeping our classrooms, school and grounds clean and tidy
- Remember to dispose of litter correctly when coming to and from school

Eco-Team:

Because we want our school to be clean, healthy, safe and green, we will:

- Bin our rubbish, or take it home in our lunch boxes.
- Not drop rubbish.
- Pick up rubbish if we see it, even if we didn't drop it - and don't forget to wash hands afterwards!
- Operate regular litter patrols (Teams of 3 Litter Pickers).
- Monitor any litter problems in the wider community and address any problems
- Eat healthy, natural fruit and vegetable snacks, which don't come in paper or plastic packaging.
- Use the right bins so that we can recycle and compost our waste - separate your rubbish into fruit / veg waste for compost.

- Promote a litter free environment to other pupils.

Communication

This policy will be shared with all staff and pupils and the wider community (website) and regularly revisited.

The Eco Warriors have worked hard to adapt the Ethos of 'it's our world'. Children understand that they are responsible for their world. Through this policy we actively encourage the whole school community to care for the environment we share, and keep it litter free.
