- To raise awareness of the importance of monitoring energy consumption by taking regular meter readings and tracking progress. Share the progress with the whole school through the Eco Warriors display board.
- To make pupils aware of the link between energy supply, use and the potential damage to the environment
- To make pupils aware of the link between energy use and cost
- Form partnerships with energy providers, who could help us put in place energy saving measures
- Encourage energy saving suggestions from all staff and pupils
- Staff and pupils will take responsibility for ensuring daily minimal energy waste and Eco Warriors will monitor classrooms to ensure lighting is turned off when the classrooms are empty.
