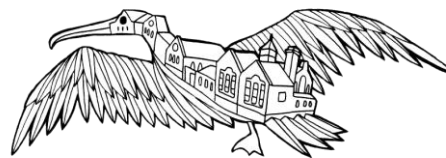

### Scooters and Bikes

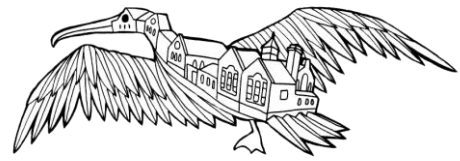
A reminder to parents to please take home all children's scooters and bikes by Tuesday. Any left by the end of Tuesday will be donated to charity.
