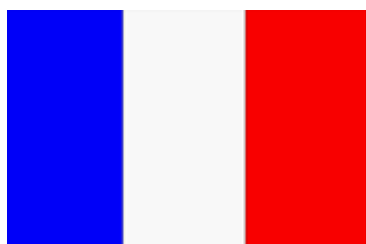


Music Tuition
