

### Pupil Premium Grant Expenditure 2013-2014

In 2011-12 the Government launched its Pupil Premium funding. This money is sent to schools based on the number of pupils in the school who are eligible for Free School Meals (FSM).

## Measuring the impact of PPG spending

As a result of the resources purchased and the interventions carried out the impact of the PPG for 2013-14 was as follows:

- 100% of children receiving PPG made National Expected progress in Reading
- 100% of children receiving PPG made National Expected progress in Writing
- 100% of children receiving PPG made National Expected progress in maths.
- 88% of children receiving PPG made above National Expected progress in Reading.
- 71% of children receiving PPG made above National Expected progress in Writing.
- 71% of children receiving PPG made above National Expected progress in Maths.
