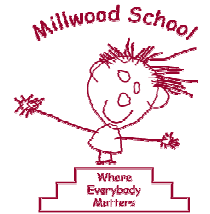

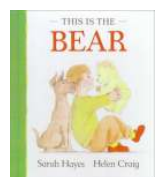


**Redvales 2** It's so great to be back at school. We have all settled beautifully into our new classes,
