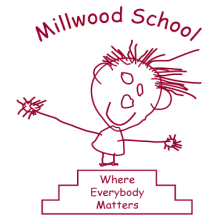

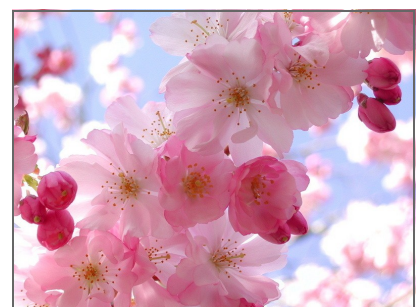
BBC Mr Tumble visit

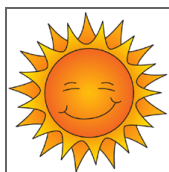

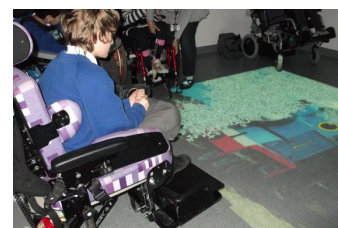
Whitelow 2 had a brilliant week. We have been exploring jungle animals this week. The children made animal masks and went on a magic train ride to the jungle. We also did

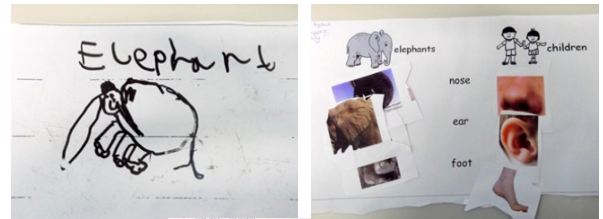
Redvales 5 We have had another busy fun-filled week! We have been using hot African colours to print with and have been acting out the story of "Handa's Surprise".



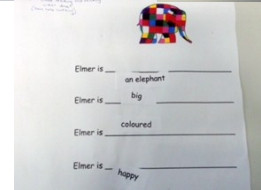
