

Forest Glade Primary PE Sport Grant Report 2013-2014

The Government is providing funding of £150 million per annum for the academic years 2013/2014 and 2014/2015 to provide new and substantial primary school sport funding. The funding is being jointly provided by the Department for Education, Health & Culture, Media and Sport, and will see money going directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all their children. The money can only be spent on sport and PE provision in schools.
