Dear Parents/Guardians

As part of our next topic, 'I am Warrior!', I have organised a trip to Lincoln to visit The Collection and have a tour of the Roman ruins. The visit will be on Wednesday 5th November 2014. The visit is a half day and the children will get to see Roman artefacts and have a tour from an expert guide looking at buildings, life as a Roman soldier and Lincoln in the Roman times.

We aim to depart from school at 9.15am and return by 12.45pm to have lunch at school. The cost of the trip will be £9 per child. This includes the visit to The Collection, an hour long tour around uphill Lincoln and the cost of the coach.

Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the visit by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made.

However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
