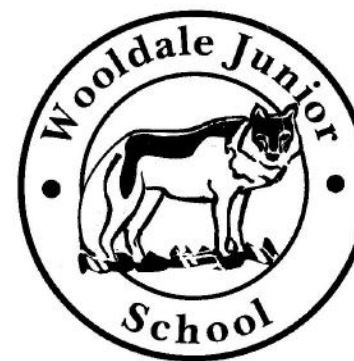

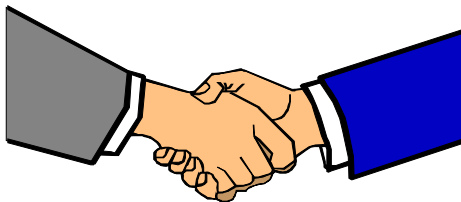
WELCOME TO WOOLDALE JUNIOR SCHOOL

- Make sure that materials borrowed from school are returned

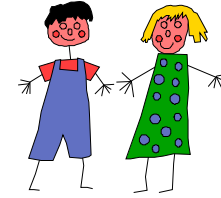
PUPILS
