At the Hyde School we strive to ensure that all our children develop a life-long love for books and reading. We believe that active encouragement of reading for pleasure is a core part of every child's educational entitlement, whatever their background or attainment. We provide a huge range of reading opportunities from a broad and balanced curriculum to promote children's pleasure for reading.

The Head Teacher sets a half termly reading challenge for our children. We expect all children to have read at least TEN TIMES at home, or independently each week. The “10 reads” consist of a variety of different quality reads; for example, reading a book, newspaper, web pages, magazines, comics, etc. These reads are recorded by the children or parents/carers into their home reading diaries. Every week their diaries are monitored by an adult in their class, to find out who has successfully achieved “The Ten Read Challenge”

At the end of the week, children who have achieved their challenge are rewarded with a special treat. So far this year there has been the BIG BOUNCE and BIG VOLLEYBALL! The children are always so eager and excited for their special reward. All children try their very best to complete their “10 Read Challenge”, and adults give extra reading time in school for some who may require this, to fly high with their reading.
