



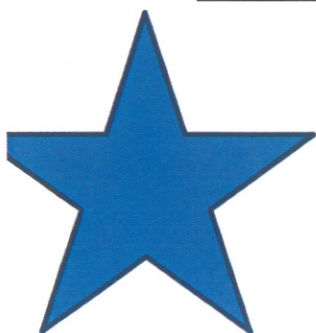
Read write Inc.
