THE CHILD

I shall:-

- Be friendly and polite in school and show respect to others by listening to what they have to say.
- Behave in a way that does not interfere with other children's learning or put them in danger of being hurt or upset.
- Always try to do my best.
- Look after my property and show respect for the property of others and of the school.
- Address all adults in the school with respect
- Wear my school uniform each day.
- Have my PE kit in school at all times.
- Always complete my homework tasks and hand them in on time.
- Behave appropriately when travelling to and from school.

THE FAMILIES

I/We Shall:-

- Ensure that my child attends regularly on time and is collected promptly at the end of the day.
- Notify the school as soon as possible if my child is unable to attend.
- Inform the school at once of any changes in contact details.
- Support the school's safety and security policy by not entering the building except via the Reception Office.
- Ensure that dogs are not brought onto the school premises.
- Drive slowly in the vicinity of the school and ensure that parking does not inconvenience our neighbours.
- Ensure that dinner money is paid in full at the appropriate time.
- Ensure my child follows the school dress code.
- Ensure that my child has PE kit in school at all times.
- Address all adults and children in school with respect and discuss the school in a positive manner.
- Engage with the school about my child's learning.

THE SCHOOL

The School will:-

- Do its best to provide a safe and secure environment.
- Provide a balance, interesting and challenging curriculum at an appropriate level for each child.
- Encourage children to show respect for others, regardless of ability, gender, age, race or religious belief.
