Medical Provision

The good health, safety and well-being of our children is paramount to all we do at John Bramston.

It is important that we have up-to-date contact details and a back up number in case of an emergency.

We

have 8 qualified First Aiders in school.

There is a medical area in school where children can rest if they feel unwell. If they are obviously not going to improve then families are contacted.



Healthy Schools

- Medicines should NOT be brought into school.
- All inhalers should be labelled and the relevant documentation completed.
- The school must be notified if your child suffers from a chronic condition or allergy.
- If your child receives a knock to his/her head, no matter how minor, you will be notified either by a phone call or letter. Your child will wear a wristband.
- Any child with specific medical condition will have a protocol agreed between home, school and the school nurse.
- Any child receiving medical attention, no matter how minor, receives a First Aid sticker. **All accidents are tracked and monitored.**
