

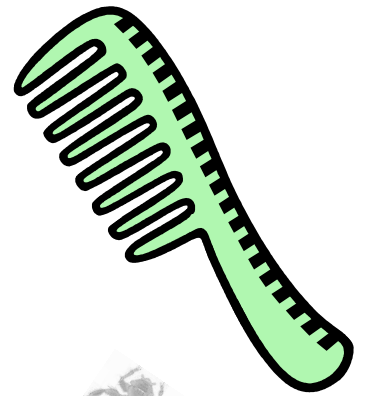
Headlice Alert !!!

A case of Headlice has been reported in your child's class.

IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU CHECK YOUR CHILD'S HAIR TONIGHT



LONG HAIR MUST BE TIED UP AT SCHOOL



Facts

- Headlice can not fly, jump or swim.
- They live in hair and are passed through close contact
- When baby louse hatches it leaves behind an empty white egg case - this is called a nit.
- All family and close contacts can easily carry headlice
- It can be up to 3 months before the symptoms such as itching occur

Detection - You should check hair at least weekly after normal hair washing by using a special comb. Combing after washing of hair is the recommended way to both
