A normal day at Highnam C of E Primary Academy

As member of the Academy Council we wanted to help you settle in, so here is a summary of what goes on in our Academy.

Morning

Normally we will start the day with Collective Worship. Mr Dean, or another teacher may lead this. Sometimes we have visiting people who come in and tell us stories from the Bible.

After Collective Worship in Year 5 and 6 there is Numeracy and then after break Literacy. In Year 3 and 4 following a guided reading session there will be Literacy and after break Numeracy. In Key Stage 1 the lessons follow a similar pattern but we stay with our class for the lessons.

Break time is great fun and is between 10:40-10:55.

Lunchtime

At Highnam C of E Primary Academy our lunchtime is between 12-1pm. We can either have a hot dinner or bring in sandwiches. The food is lovely here and often the teachers will eat with us too.




In the Role Play Area
