Dear Parent/Guardian

To support and enhance our 'Frozen Kingdom' geography topic, I have organised a visit to The Deep in Hull on Thursday 12th February. This will be a full day visit and the children will take part in a 'Penguin Detectives' workshop, as well as having the chance to look around the rest of the centre. This will include a visit to the 'Kingdom of Ice' area where the children will observe the resident *Gentoo* penguins.

We intend to depart from school at 9.00am, so please could children be in school at the slightly earlier time of 8.45am on that day. We will be returning at approximately 3.30 p.m. The children will need to bring a packed lunch and drink as usual and will need to be dressed in ***school uniform (sweatshirt/ cardigan, suitable trousers and footwear)***. If your child suffers with travel sickness it would be advisable to administer the travel sickness tablet before they come to school and enclose another tablet for the return journey in a named envelope.

In order to run this visit we have to raise the cost of entry and transport which works out at £10.00 per place. The deadline for reply slips and payment is Friday 6th February 2015.

Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the (visit, activity, etc.) by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made.

However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
