- **Achieved** 0 to 90% recycling in under 12 months and received a National Award from the House of Commons and donated funds to charity
- **Saved** the school over £50,000 a year in Utility costs
- Successfully **bid** for £125,000 of energy efficiency funding which has also improved the school environment and facilities
- Been **selected** by the Greater Manchester Combined Authority to act as a role model to advise other schools across Manchester
- Recently **advised** the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change on strategies to help other UK schools make similar improvements
