Dear Parents/Guardian

As part of our next topic, 'Predators', I have organised a trip to Woodside Falconry Park on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2015. The visit is a full day and the children will get to see a variety of different predators, see real-life displays and have hands-on experiences.

We aim to depart from school at 9.15am and return by 3pm in time for the end of school. Children will need a packed lunch to eat at the park.

The cost of the trip will be £12 per child. This includes the visit to Woodside, a guided tour with educational workshop and the cost of the coach.

Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the (visit, activity, etc.) by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made.

The deadline for reply slips and payment is Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> February 2015. However, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient.
