## The curriculum within the Early Years Foundation Stage at Knowles Nursery School is planned around four main themes:

A Unique Child	Positive Relationships	Enabling Environments	Learning and Development
Every child is a unique child, who is constantly learning and can be resilient, capable, confident and self-assured.	Children learn to be strong and independent from a base of loving and secure relationships with parents and/or a key person.	The environment plays a key role in supporting and extending children's development and learning.	Children learn and develop in different ways and at different rates and all areas of Learning and Development are equally important and interconnected.

Learning and Development is divided into 3 prime areas and 4 specific areas and is underpinned by playing and exploring, active learning and thinking critically.

## Effective teaching and learning includes:

- playing and exploring children investigate and experience things, and 'have a go';
- active learning children concentrate and keep on trying if they encounter difficulties, and enjoy achievements
- **creating and thinking critically** children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things.
