

## **SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY**

The school strongly recommends the wearing of school uniform by all pupils at all times. School uniform is compulsory for children when they are representing the school, e.g. school choir. Black shoes must be worn at all times; flat-heeled leather sandals may be worn in the summer. Trainers or plimsolls must be worn for outside games.

The school uniform consists of the following: -

Green Sweatshirt with School logo
Green cardigan with School logo
Green fleece with School logo
Yellow polo shirt with School logo
Black (or dark grey) trousers (boys and girls)
Black (or dark grey) skirt
Gingham type summer dresses are acceptable and should be in green and white or yellow and white.

Green sweatshirts, cardigans, fleeces and yellow polo shirts may be bought from the school office. The school regularly reviews and adds to these items.

P.E. uniform should be school P.E. kit or dark shorts and white/light colour t-shirt. Trunks or swimming costumes must be worn for swimming, with a swimming cap to cover the hair. P.E. t-shirts and shorts, swimming costumes, trunks and caps may be purchased from the school. Football boots may be worn on the playing field for football.

Book bags and Gym/Swim bags are available. The book bag is green, but the gym/swim bags are in the team colours of red, blue, yellow and green.

We do **not** encourage children to wear jewellery, however, pupils may wear a watch and stud style earrings on the understanding that all jewellery is removed for any form of P.E. and that each pupil is responsible for their own jewellery. Long hair **must** be tied back for P.E. and in the classroom.

Pupils' hair should  $\underline{not}$  be dyed – this is only allowed on 'special' days such as for Comic Relief. If pupils' hair is coloured/highlighted it should be of a naturally occurring colour.

Pupils may not wear jeans, sports kits, tracksuits or any sort of beachwear.
