Dear Parents/Guardian

As part of our next topic, 'Scrumdiddlyumptious', I have organised a trip to Lincoln to visit the Tesco Extra store on Wragby Road. The visit will take place on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> April 2015 and will be for half a day. We will visit different areas of the store following the 'Farm to Fork' trail. We aim to depart from school at 9.00am and return to school by 12.45pm, where we will have a healthy picnic lunch, which will be provided for the children.

The cost of the trip will be £3.50 per child. This includes the visit to the Tesco store, the coach journey and the picnic lunch. Tesco have subsidised part of our trip and this is reflected in the cost. These visits form an integral part of the curriculum and, as such, are extremely worthwhile. Parents are under no obligation and no child will be omitted because parents are unwilling or unable to contribute.

We would appreciate slips and payment by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2015, if possible and I apologise for the lateness of the notice.

In order to run this visit we have to raise the cost of tickets, entry, transport, etc. which works out at £3.50 per place.

Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 (as consolidated in the Education Act 1996) we can only raise the cost of the (visit, activity, etc.) by voluntary contribution. There is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made.
