Impact of funding

Our spending has already had a big impact on the children's participation in sport and being active. All children from Reception – Year 6 take part weekly in our Carlisle United PE coaching. Every term a different sport is taught eg. Football, dance, gymnastics, team games.

The Infant (R – Yr 6) children in school have also been given the opportunity to take part in Forest School. This is occasionally taught at Bassenthwaite Lake but is also incorporated with outdoor learning in the school grounds. The Infants do Welly Wednesday where the majority of the day is spent learning in the outdoor environment.

Allerdale Sports Partnership provides qualified coaches in tennis, cricket & multi skills.

Tennis nets and balls were purchased after advice from our tennis coach. The children use this equipment with a coach but also use in general outdoor play. Tennis practice impacts a lot on our children as many have taken up tennis coaching after school and some have played for Allerdale and even the County. Cricket taught in school has also led to some children taking cricket up after school.

Two children, who are Gifted and Talented in sport were given the amazing opportunity to attend Chance Camp in Cockermouth during the Easter holidays, this was funded by school.
