CORE AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Literacy</p> 	<p>In literacy this half term the children will be writing their own Traditional Tales. We will look closely at the work of Beatrix Potter</p> <p>After half term we will be learning about Mythical Stories and thinking of their own mythical beasts! We will also be doing some instructional writing during our big Roman project.</p>
<p>Maths</p> 	<p>Over the course of this term we will be recapping on the new learning children have been challenged with during Year 3. We will be developing their fractions knowledge so they can add and find equivalent fractions as well as increasing their problem solving techniques.</p> <p>After half term we will return to addition and subtraction and extend the learning through real world applications such as statistics, design skills and shape knowledge..</p>
<p>Science</p>	<p>This half term our science topic will be plants. Children will be carrying out experiments on them, learning about their parts and even grow their own!</p> <p>After half term we will be studying famous scientists throughout history. We will look at their work and children will learn how to work in a more scientific way to become scientists themselves.</p>
<p>ICT</p> 	<p>In ICT children will learn about algorithms. They will be debugging and fixing programmes. This will be using the SCRATCH system children have used throughout the year.</p> <p>After half term the children will use all their knowledge of SCRATCH and programming from Year 3 to create an amazing end of year animation. They will be designing, programming and debugging the programme themselves.</p>

ENRICHMENT AREAS OF LEARNING

<p>Topic</p> 	<p>Our first topic is entitled 'Bloomin' Marvellous' . As part of the topic, children will be learning and using a range of fields skills linked to their learning in science. Children will observe, measure and record natural features out in the field recording these using a range of skills such as sketching and graph making.</p> <p>After half term children will be 'Roman all over the world' as we look at the Roman civilisation and their impact on Britain. This topic will have many cross curricular links to Literacy, Maths and D&T</p>
<p>RE</p>	<p>As part of our RE this term we'll be looking at Worship. Children will look at how and why different religions worship and consider the impact this has on an individual.</p> <p>After half term we will be learning about Beliefs in Action. Children will look at concepts such as right and wrong, justice and human rights. We will look at the factors effecting these and the inequalities still felt by some sections of the community.</p>
<p>Art & Design</p>	<p>We begin Summer Term with an Art focus; children will look at the work of Georgia O'Keefe and apply their skills to a piece inspired by her.</p> <p>After half term we will using our D&T skills to build our own Roman town. This will have strong links to our Topic learning and Maths skills.</p>
<p>PE</p>	<p>Children will continue swimming every Wednesday and in school they will begin to develop their tennis skills.</p> <p>Their swimming continues after half term, and in school we will be building up our athletics skills.</p>
