Sports Premium 2014 – 2015

This year, we will continue to pay membership towards Ashton Park Sports partnership and the Youth sports Trust to provide us with a programme of sports competitions with other schools, training for teachers, networking and taster days for children to try out new skills.

We hope to run 6 after school sports clubs this year to include two netball clubs for Y3/4 and Y5/6, tag rugby Y3/4/5/6, football Y1-6, dance YR-Y6 and gymnastics Y1/2. We want to build upon the success of last year and will once again monitor how many children participate in extra curricular activity including our Reception classes for the first time. We will also be running an additional Change for Life club at lunchtime and will be entering B teams in some inter-sport competitions.

This year, we have invited our gymnastics coaches back to team teach with our staff for the Autumn and Spring Term and following an audit have asked for Tag Rugby coaches to come and team teach in the Summer term. All year, Years 2-6 will also benefit from an additional swim instructor during curriculum swimming lessons to improve the quality of provision and outcomes for the children.

We plan to purchase teaching aids for Foundation Stage and KS1 to ensure consistency of PE teaching across the school and will introduce assessment of the subject into KS1. We hope to embed assessment procedures in KS2 and will set up a planned programme of intra-sport house competitions across the year with the help of some Sports

Leaders, a group of children selected to help develop PE and School Sports further and to represent the children's opinions in the school.

We plan to update our school website to include a sports page which will feature match reports, next fixtures, results and photographs/videos and will celebrate the achievements of our children on school newsletters also.

In line with the School Improvement plan for 2014-15 we aim to improve children's writing by offering groups of children the opportunity to write about Sports fixtures and professional matches and five boys have signed contracts with a Football/Learning Academy, which provides training but also sets targets with teachers for learning in school.

Pupil premium is also used for eligible children to encourage participation in clubs and activities

With the additional provision in place, we hope to be eligible to receive the accredited Sainsburys School games Silver Award at the end of the academic year.
