Term	Objectives covered	Activity
Autumn	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products• Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space	<p>The children will study body pictures. They will share experiences and imagination to produce their own self-portrait.</p> <p>They create patterns using hands/fingers/feet.</p> <p>The children produce an autumn picture studying colour pattern and shape.</p>
Spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space	<p>The children will look at the sculpture - artist - Abel Ramirez.</p> <p>Children will look at his work and then make a sculpture of an igloo.</p>
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space• Recognise the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work	<p>The children produce seaside paintings based on the artist studied. They compare Van Gogh Seascape to Natalie Pascoe Cornish paintings.</p>

Autumn	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products • Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space • Recognise the work of a range of artists, craft makers and designers, describing the differences and similarities between different practices and disciplines, and making links to their own work 	<p>The children will study the work of William Morris and Cath Kidston to compare style, pattern and techniques. They will apply this knowledge to create a piece of textile artwork.</p>
Spring	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space 	<p>Children pick out six key points from the stories and draw a simple sketch storyboard. From this storyboard make a new simple sketch incorporating all of the important elements from the storyboard to make a painting.</p>
Summer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Use a range of materials creatively to design and make products • Develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space 	<p>Look at the work of Gillian Ayres and use polytile printing to make printed wallpaper inspired by flowers. Use different line texture using hatching and colour to produce a farm scene.</p>
