Dear Parents/Carers,

We are writing to clarify our recent letter regarding the administration of antibiotics. If a child has been prescribed antibiotics they will be allowed into school or residence as long as they are well. The child must be given a **full day's dose** of the antibiotic over a 24 hour period (i.e. the 2, 3 or 4 daily doses prescribed) at home before the medication can be sent into school. Parents should contact the school/residence prior to sending antibiotics in with their child. In addition to this you must ensure that the prescription label is visible and gives clear instructions and that the medication is in date and is prescribed for your child. If your child appears unwell you will be contacted and asked to collect them.

We must also advise you that we do not have a fridge for the storage of medication.
