To help with the Fair we shall be having a **Non-Uniform Day on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June.**

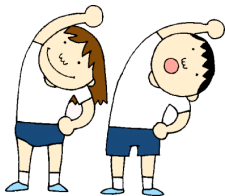
- ❖ Children in Nursery, **Reception and Year 1** are asked to bring **cakes.**
